**RE: Burglary Investigation**

Sheriff David Gould reports that The Cayuga County Sheriff's Office is asking for the public's help in solving a major burglary at a storage barn located on Rt. 20 in the Town of Sennett. The burglary is believed to have occurred during the last week of June. Unknown suspect (s) forced entry to the barn by removing the wood siding.

Stolen was a large amount of high grade sports equipment and sport clothing including several pairs of men's, women's and youth downhill and cross country skis. A large amount of ski equipment such as ski clothing, helmets, poles, goggles etc., tennis equipment and tennis clothing along with two pairs of snowshoes. Also stolen were high grade telescopes and various telescope accessories, power tools such as a pneumatic nailer, drill, circular saw, jig saw, air compressor etc., hand tools such as hammers, vice grips numerous sets of pliers etc. Also stolen was a roof storage box that fits on top of a car. Many of the stolen items were stored in large plastic totes some clear and some black which were also stolen. The loss is estimated at over \$19,000.
